

TASRAIL LICENCE APPLICATION – PRIVATE CROSSING

FORM

Under Section 108 of Rail Safety National Law a Safety Interface agreement (or Licence) is required to manage the safety risk at a private level crossing in conjunction with TasRail as the Rail Infrastructure Manager.

Please follow these steps when applying for a Level Crossing Licence:

- 1. Complete Section A and ensure you attach all requested information, including:
 - Details of requested use
 - Copy of Insurance Certificates
 - Photo of crossing site
 - Trust Deed if applicable
 - Payment Details if applicable
- 2. Complete Section B and check you have read and understood the mandatory Standard Conditions and make sure you have ticked and initialed all boxes, otherwise the application will be deemed invalid.
- 3. Ensure you have signed the application Declarations on pages 2 and 3.
- 4. Complete Application Fees.

	Applicant acknowledges and agrees that if approved, the Crossing Licence is not an authorisation or consent for any works to be carried out within the rail corridor.	
	Applicant certifies that it will not commence access over any part of the railway corridor until such time as it has received written authorisation to do so from TasRail and/or the Crossing Licence is approved and issued.	
	Applicant acknowledges and agrees not to place any materials over the railway track or formation or at any location within the rail corridor. This includes a prohibition of any signage or other infrastructure inside rail land.	
□ or N/A □	If applicable - Stock Crossings only - Applicant acknowledges and agrees to comply with the TasRail Safety Procedure for Stock Crossings at all times by telephoning Train Control prior to entering the rail corridor each time and immediately once clear of the line. A copy of this procedure will be issued to the applicant with the Licence.	
	Applicant certifies that the use of the railway crossing by steel tracked vehicles is strictly prohibited . Examples of prohibited tracked vehicles include excavators, bulldozers etc.	
	Applicant acknowledges and agrees not to install any services in the rail corridor without the written approval and/or issuing of a separate permit by TasRail. This also applies to discharge of any water or stormwater into the rail corridor which is strictly prohibited.	
	Applicant acknowledges that if maintenance works are required to sustain the condition of the crossing at any time during the Term of the Licence, TasRail reserves the right to invoice the Licensee for this cost.	
	Applicant acknowledges and agrees to immediately report any damage that is observed in the rail corridor or that occurs to TasRail property during the course of the permitted access. Where such damage is as a result of an act of negligence or omission by the Licensee, TasRail reserves the right to recover the associated repair costs from the Licensee and/or to terminate the Licence.	
	Applicant acknowledges and agrees to immediately advise TasRail if the crossing signage requires replacement or repair.	
	Applicant certifies that it will continue to maintain Public Liability Insurance to the value of \$20 million throughout the term of the Licence and agrees to provide TasRail with evidence of such Insurance Certificate following each renewal.	
	Applicant acknowledges and agrees to pay TasRail an Annual Licence Fee on the first anniversary of the commencement date and each anniversary date thereafter. TasRail will invoice the applicant for this fee, with payment terms at 7 days.
